



ATTACHMENT A PROJECT UPDATE:
COMPLETED CONTROL STRATEGIES
FOR 6/28/2012 NAC VISIT

ESCO has completed the control strategy building and operational changes for the following emission reduction projects. These projects are part of Attachment A to the ESCO/Neighbor Good Neighbor Agreement (GNA). The Method of Confirmation has been completed for these projects and they will continue to be managed per the GNA.

PROJECT #8: Modify operational specifications to limit door and other openings to improve capture on Electric Arc Furnace (EAF) and Argon Oxygen Decarburization (AOD) baghouses, Main Plant and Plant 3.

Actions: ESCO has modified the Overhead Door Plans for both the Main Plant and Plant 3 to further limit the potential for fugitive emissions. ESCO has also gone beyond the GNA requirements to add a walk-through door that will further minimize the need to open the overhead door. Also, one of the manual overhead doors has been replaced with an automatic one so the door can be closed easily.

Results: Reductions in PM and Metallic HAP's.

Method of Confirmation: ESCO will inspect the EAF and AOD areas during regular monthly fugitive emissions inspections and maintain records of the inspections. Neighbor groups may now inspect EAF and AOD areas and inspect audit records.
